HELP! HELP! HELP!

The Campaign Against Arms Trade needs £10,000 before the end of December to enable us to start 1986 and life in our new offices without debts. Can YOU help us?

A debt of around £8,500 has been accumulated because of our success in raising the issue of the arms trade. In particular the Bread not Bombs Weeks of Action in 1984 and 1985 cost us a lot more in materials than we raised through sales and donations. We have yet to pay our printers for many of the leaflets you used last May.

For 1986 we have a £38,000 budget. Unfortunately this doesn't allow for advertising or building up contingency reserves. But before we can approach the future with confidence we need to pay off the accumulation of past bills. This is why for the first time we are sending out a separate appeal mailing to all our supporters.

Many CAAT supporters already give generously to the campaign, others spend a lot locally while working against the arms trade, while others still live on low incomes. But we hope some of you could make us an early Christmas present to help us avoid entering 1986 with the millstone of debt round our necks. Could YOU do so? If only 1,000 CAAT supporters gave £10 each we'd be able to pay off our debts straight away. So please fill in the form below and return it to us with your donation.

If any of you would like a copy of the 1986 budget, just ask the office. And for everyone's information the much-heralded move is now unlikely to take place until after Christmas due to further legal complications.
